From South:

Interstate (95) North to George Washington Bridge to (295) to Throgs Neck Bridge * Stay in right lane of bridge * Cross Island Parkway Exit (campers or commercial vehicles to Clearview Expressway Exit) * Exit to Long Island Expressway East (495) * See Directions from NYC below.

From New York City (NYC)

Long Island Expressway (495) East to exit 70 * Rte 111 south to Sunrise Hwy, Rte 27 * Right on Exit 7, SUNY Stony Brook University * Left at light * 1/2 miles make a right on to Reservation * Follow signs to Powwow grounds.

From East:

Montauk Hwy, Rte 27A west through Southampton Village * Follow signs to Powwow grounds.

By Train or Bus:

Long Island Railroad to Southampton Train Station * Take Powwow Shuttle Bus. Taxis are available at Southampton Bus Station

By Plane:

MacArthur Airport, Islip New York * south to Sunrise Hwy, Rte 27 * Right on Exit 7, Stony Brook University * Left at light * 1/2 miles make a right on to Reservation * Follow signs to Powwow grounds.

From Conn/Orient Point Ferry:

Route 25 West to Rte 105 * 105 South to Rte 24 * Left at Rte 24 * South to Sunrise Hwy, Rte 27 * Right on Exit 7, Stony Brook University * Left at light * 1/2 miles make a right on to Reservation * Follow signs to Powwow grounds.
